

Privacy policy – Spitfire Technology Group

This policy relates to the processing of personal data as undertaken by Spitfire Technology Group, the trading name of the group of companies comprising:

We collect certain information or data about you when you use www.spitfire.co.uk and related media links.

What information is collected?

- Details to allow you to access services and transactions, for example, an email address
- Your IP address, and details of which version of web browser you used to ask questions, or to leave queries or feedback, including your email address if you send an email to us
- Information on how you use the site, using cookies and page tagging techniques to help us improve the website
- Details when registering or applying for jobs

This allows us to:

- improve the site by monitoring how you use it
- respond to any feedback you send us, if you've asked us to
- provide you with information about local services if you want it
- understand your preferences so that we can improve the products or services we offer

If you make an enquiry about our products or services whether via our website, telephone or email we will collect information about you in order to respond to your enquiry.

What information is collected?

- Details to allow us to communicate with you, for example your email address and telephone numbers
- Information relating to your position in your company, for example your job title, place of work and role
- If you are a company director we may also process data relating to your directorship that is in the public domain

This allows us to:

- Communicate effectively with you whilst we respond to your enquiry
- Provide you with information on other products and services if you choose to receive such information
- Provide our services to you based on accurate information

All data processing undertaken by Spitfire is carried out on a lawful basis as per the General Data Protection Regulation, Article 6(1).

Where is the data stored and is it secure?

We store your data on our secure servers in the UK. We have a number of security measures and features that are implemented to try and ensure the safety of any information in our possession or control, once we receive it, with limited access from our technical staff.

Transmitting information over the internet is generally not completely secure, and we can't guarantee the security of your data. Any data you transmit is at your own risk.

By submitting your personal data, you agree to this.

We won't share your information with any other organisations for marketing, market research or commercial purposes, and we don't pass on your details to other websites.

Payment transactions are always encrypted.

Disclosing your information

In line with GDPR Article 6(1)(c) we may pass on your personal information and exchange any of your details if we have a legal obligation to do so, or if we have to enforce or apply our terms and conditions or other agreements.
