

Government Ethernet Grant Schemes



Access Broadband Cymru (ABC)



- Premises must be in Wales
- New connection needs to at least double download speeds compared to current service
- Use to upgrade to Fibre Broadband or Fibre Ethernet
- £400 or £800 voucher towards installation and router costs



Ultrafast Connectivity Scheme



- Premises must be in Wales
- New connection needs to have at least 100Mbps download speeds
- Use to upgrade to Fibre Ethernet
- Up to £10,000 towards installation and router hardware costs





- Premises within Westminster City Council
- Eligible for businesses with download speeds that do not exceed 30Mbps
- Scheme to assist businesses upgrade to Gigabit capable connections (but can be used for 100Mb bearer circuits)
- Grant up to £2,000 covering upfront charges



Local Full Fibre Networks (LFFN) Vouchers Scheme



- Aberdeenshire, Bristol, Bath, North East Somerset,
 Coventry, Warwickshire, West Yorkshire or West Sussex
- New connection must be 1Gb capable for the future (can be 100Mb bearer initially) and deliver minimum of 100Mb
- Spitfire Pre-Approved Packages on 100Mb (12 months)
 or 1Gb (12 or 36 months) voucher covers £3,000 of
 either upfront or ongoing charges



Spitfire's Amazon Ethernet Incentive



- Amazon Voucher available for the lead and sale of an Ethernet Circuit from a Spitfire Partner
- £25 voucher for a 10 90Mb Fibre Ethernet Circuit
- £50 voucher for 100Mb and over Fibre Ethernet circuit
- Running until 30th March 2018
- Terms & conditions apply



Government Ethernet Grant Schemes - Summary

- Spitfire are approved suppliers for all of the mentioned schemes
- For the Welsh and Connect Westminster Schemes, onus is on the end user to apply for the funding with the relevant authority.
 Spitfire can advise on this process.
- With LFFN, the application process is done through Spitfire using Pre-Approved voucher
